



SEVERE WEATHER EMERGENCY KIT

- Water**—At least 1 gallon per person for 3 days. 
- Food**—Non-perishable items. If including canned foods, don't forget the can opener!
- Weather Radio**—Battery-powered or hand-cranked radios in case cell service goes down.
- Flashlights/Lanterns**—Don't forget extra batteries! 
- Power Bank**—To charge cellphones and other devices.
- First Aid Kit**—Be sure to include bandages, ointment, disinfectant wipes, pain relievers and medication.
- Hygiene Items**—Toilet paper, wet wipes, garbage bags with ties for personal sanitation.
- Sleeping Bag or Blanket**—Recommended one for each person in your home
- Pet Supplies**—If you have pets, be sure to have extra food, litter, water, crates or carriers, and leashes.
- Important Documents**—Identification, insurance information, etc. in a waterproof bag.
- Baby/Child Supplies**—Formula, snacks, comfort items such as books, toys, etc.
- Dust Mask**—One for each person in the house in case air gets dusty.
- Change of Clothes**—At least one for each person in the home. Be sure to also include a jacket, gloves and closed toe shoes for walking.
- Rain Gear**—One for each person in the home.
- Helmet**—One for each person in the home in case of debris.
