I, Vicki Zemp Behenna, the undersigned District Attorney of Oklahoma County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, informs the District Court that:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY TO DISTRIBUTE A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) ~ a FELONY. On or about March 31, 2025 and April 1, 2025, in Oklahoma County, the crime of CONSPIRACY TO DISTRIBUTE MARIJUANA was committed by **SHENG QU, HOU RUN LIU, JIE YU, TINGTING LIANG and DEPING SUN**, who conspired with one another and others unknown by agreeing to unlawfully distribute marijuana, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, from a warehouse at 301 N. Rhode Island Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, and whose overt acts in furtherance of said conspiracy included, but were not limited to: arranging for the delivery of black market marijuana from marijuana grows, and/or receiving packages of such marijuana at said location, hiding that marijuana within furniture boxes, building wooden crates, placing the marijuana-filled furniture boxes into the crates, arranging for freight trucking companies to pick up and deliver the crates outside the State of Oklahoma, and loading the marijuana-filled crates onto those

freight trucks, contrary to the provisions of Section 421 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.


COUNT 2: AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) ~ a FELONY. On or about March 31, 2025, at or near 301 N. Rhode Island Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, **SHENG QU, HOU RUN LIU, JIE YU, TINGTING LIANG and DEPING SUN**, committed the crime of AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) ~ a FELONY, by possessing over 1000 pounds of marijuana, a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, contrary to the provisions of Section 2-415 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 3: AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) ~ a FELONY. On or about April 1, 2025, at or near 301 N. Rhode Island Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, **SHENG QU, HOU RUN LIU, JIE YU, TINGTING LIANG and DEPING SUN**, committed the crime of AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) ~ a FELONY, by possessing over 1000 pounds of marijuana, a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, contrary to the provisions of Section 2-415 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 4: USE OF A FIREARM IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY ~ a FELONY. On or about April 1, 2025, **SHENG QU** committed the crime of USE OF A FIREARM IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY by knowingly and willfully possessing an assault rifle at 301 N. Rhode Island Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, while committing the felony of Trafficking in Marijuana, with such possession being connected to the commission of said felony, contrary to the provisions of Section 1287 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 5: POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (MARIJUANA) WITH THE INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE ~ a FELONY. On or about April 1, 2025, the crime of POSESSION OF MARIJUANA WITH THE INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE was committed by **JIAN YONG CHEN**, who knowingly possessed with the intent to distribute marijuana, a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, at or near the intersection of Northeast 3rd Street and North Kate Avenue, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, contrary to the provisions of Section 2-401(A) of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.





Under miranda AR LIU admitted that he built the wooden crates for the marijuana to be stashed in and disguised as bathroom vanities. Law enforcement interdicted those two freight shipments and seized approximately 1700 pounds of marijuana. On April 1st, 2025 AR LIU was arrested for that load of 1700 pounds and admitted under miranda to having knowledge that the boxes he had built contained marijuana and not vanities.

On 4/1/25, at approximately 1340 hours, members of the Oklahoma City Police Department executed a search warrant at a warehouse at 301 N. Rhode Island, Suite 109, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County. The search warrant was authorized by The Honorable Judge Stallings.

Upon warrant execution AR sheng was seen leaving in a blue Honda accord. Sheng had been identified as a member of the DTO and the Honda had been identified as a courier vehicle of the DTO. Sheng was detained. Under miranda SHENG admitted that he was the boss of the DTO and that he knew that packaging marijuana and shipping it out of Oklahoma was illegal. SHENG admitted under miranda that the other individuals worked for him in the packaging and illegal distribution of marijuana.

AR Sun was taken into custody leaving the warehouse at the time of execution. Under Miranda he admitted to packaging up marijuana in the crates that AR LIU built. AR SUN admitted that he was leaving the warehouse to pick up a load of marijuana at NE 3rd and Kate.

AR Chen was the person that AR SUN was going to meet to pick up a load of marijuana. AR CHEN had a box of marijuana in the trunk of his car at NE 3rd and Kate. AR CHEN stated that he picked up the box in the middle of the road or at a gas station in Edmond to bring to NE 3rd and Kate.

AR LIANG and AR YU were taken into custody in the warehouse at the time of execution. Both admitted under miranda to working at the warehouse to package up the crates that AR LIU built with the marijuana that was brought to the warehouse. Approximately 1000 pounds of marijuana was found in the warehouse located at this address. Law enforcement also recovered a loaded AR 15 rifle and dominlon and control for AR LIU and AT SHENG.

This all happened in Oklahoma county, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
