EXECUTIVE ORDER 2025-10

I, J. Kevin Stitt, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps to be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half-staff from 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 19, 2025 through 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 25, 2025, in honor of the 30th anniversary of the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on April 19, 1995.

30 years ago, 168 innocent lives were tragically lost in the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City. This senseless act of violence remains the deadliest act of domestic terrorism in the history of the United States. Among those killed were men, women, and children whose memories live on in the hearts of Oklahomans and Americans across the nation.

In the face of evil, Oklahomans responded with a compassion, courage, and strength that became known as the Oklahoma Standard. On the 30th anniversary of that solemn day, we recommit ourselves to the values that carried us through: faith, community, and love for our neighbor—and we pause to honor the lives lost, the survivors, the first responders, and all whose lives were forever changed.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Division of Capital Assets Management, who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
